If you would like to donate items for re-use, please check what we can and cannot take. We endeavour to enable the reuse of as many items as possible, however unfortunately we are unable to take certain items due to their hazardous or non-recyclable nature, or due to the lack of suitable storage and sales space.

Proper Job and many other charities are finding it increasingly difficult to pass on low quality donations to ethical and environmentally responsible third party collectors. Low quality, damaged and dirty donations cost the charity money to dispose of. Please pre-sort and check your donations before you come, if the items are not suitable for reuse please put it in your council refuse.

Some items are problematic due to the large quantities we receive; therefore please do not be offended if we are unable to accept your donations. As a donor it is your responsibility to ensure that you are doing the best thing for the charity and environment. **Check it before you bring it, give us a ring if you are unsure.**
